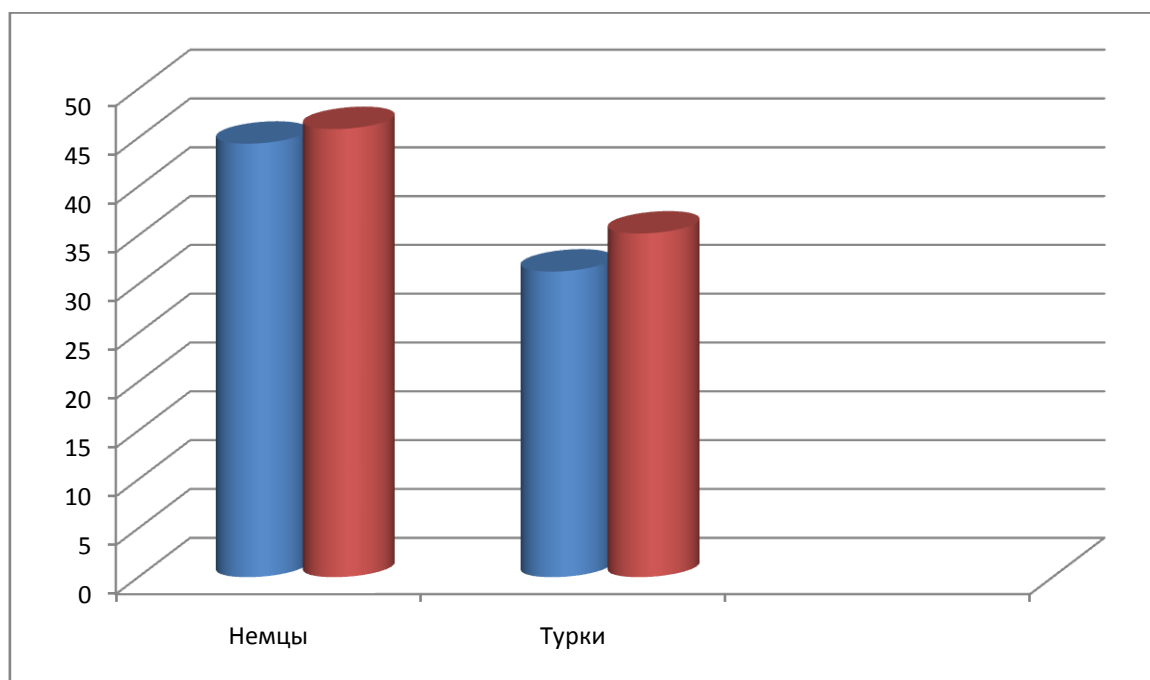
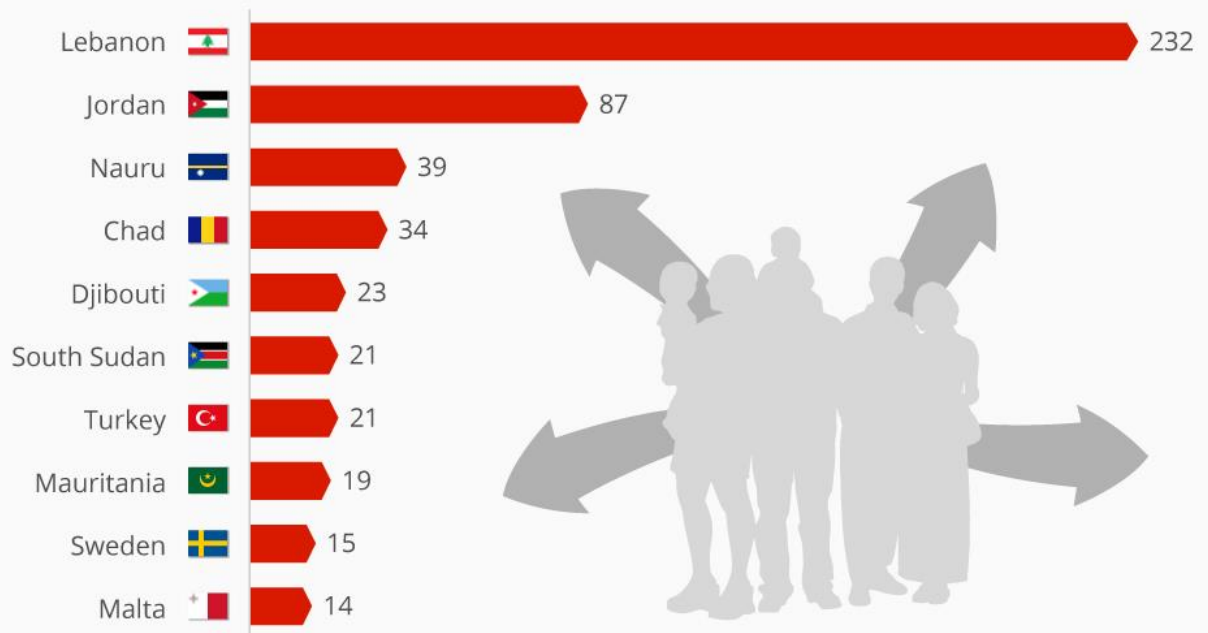

Number of refugees per 1,000 inhabitants in 2014

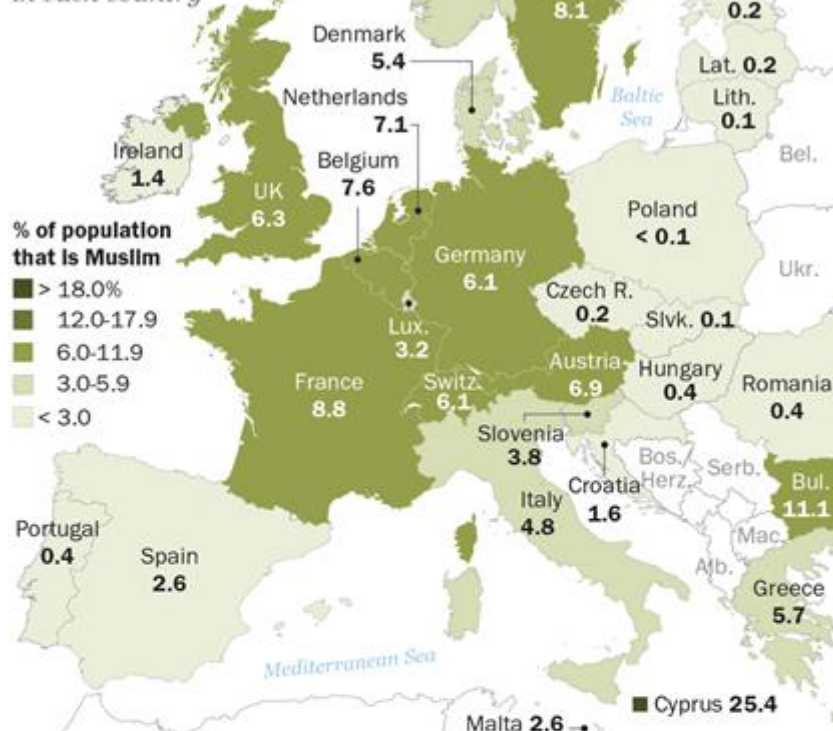

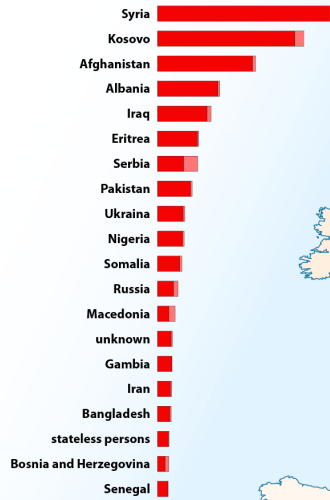

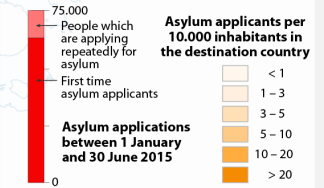

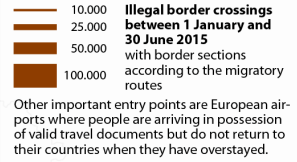

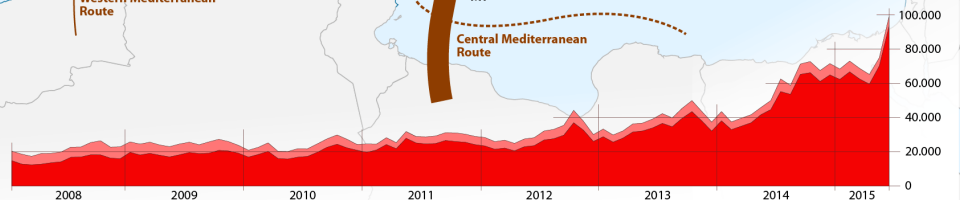

Islamophobic crimes in London:

from July 2014 to July 2015
(Source: Metropolitan Police Service)

The Metropolitan Police recorded **816** Islamophobic crimes between July 2014 to July 2015

This is up from **478** Islamophobic crimes between July 2013 to July 2014.

Details are provided in the map on the right, by London borough. Each detail includes the number of incidents between July 2014 to July 2015, followed by the percentage increase of Islamophobic crime over the previous year (2013-2014).

There are major increases across London, notably in boroughs with high levels of deprivation, where (according to the Crime Survey of England and Wales) residents tend to experience hate crime more frequently.

Also alarming are the large increases in outer London boroughs which have previously experienced few Islamophobic or anti-Muslim crimes.

Islamophobia is on the rise. Since 2014, with the rise of the so-called 'Islamic State' and the attack on Charlie Hebdo in Paris, anti-Muslim perceptions have hardened and continue to negatively affect Muslims in the capital.

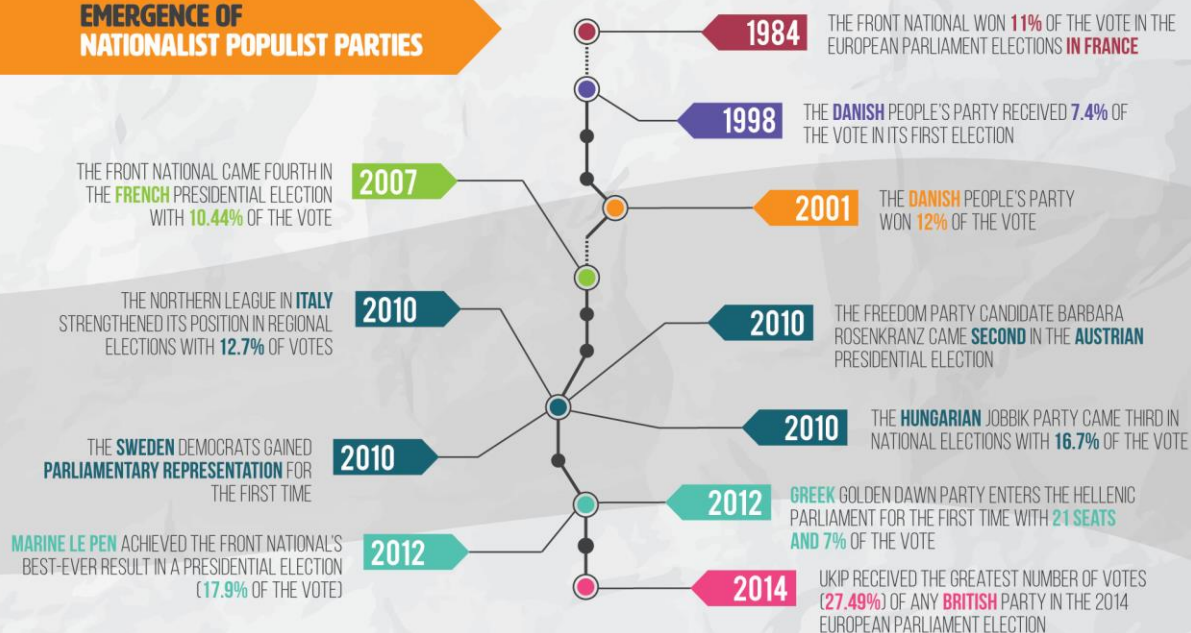

HOW CAN WE EXPLAIN THE RISE OF THESE PARTIES?

- ▶ LOSS OF PUBLIC CONFIDENCE IN MAINSTREAM POLITICAL PARTIES
- ▶ THE EU IS SEEN AS AN OPEN DOOR FOR IMMIGRANTS WHO ARE THREATENING NATIONAL CULTURES AND SAFETY
- ▶ ALL THESE PARTIES OR MOVEMENTS HAVE BENEFITED FROM THE FINANCIAL AND ECONOMIC CRISIS AND A CONTEXT OF DISAPPOINTMENT IN MAINSTREAM POLITICAL PARTIES AND EUROPEAN INSTITUTIONS
- ▶ MANY VOTERS SEE THESE PARTIES AS A WAY TO PROTEST AGAINST POLICIES WITHIN THE EU SUCH AS AUSTERITY, LACK OF JOBS, AND IMMIGRATION

VOTERS WHO TURN OUT FOR NATIONAL POPULIST PARTIES AT ELECTIONS TEND TO BE MEN

SUPPORT FOR POPULIST NATIONALIST PARTIES IS WEAK AMONG MORE SECURE AND SALARIED SECTIONS OF THE MIDDLE CLASSES AND CITIZENS WITH A UNIVERSITY-LEVEL EDUCATION

POPULIST PARTIES ARE ENDORSED BY CITIZENS WHO HAVE A NEGATIVE ATTITUDE TOWARDS IMMIGRANTS, REFUGEES AND CULTURAL AND ETHNIC DIVERSITY

According to the latest polls, Geert Wilders and his Party for Freedom could become the No. 1 party in parliament.

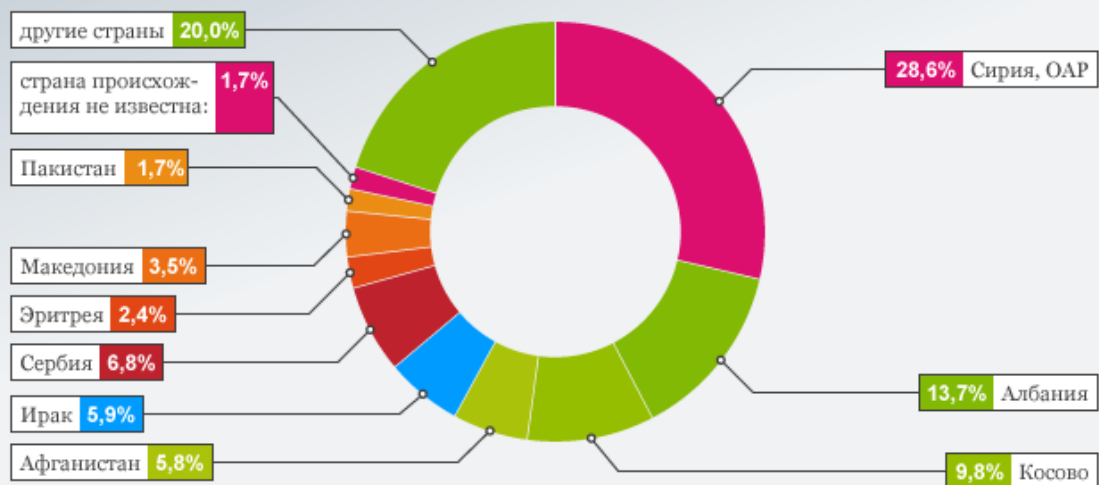
Elections in Autumn 2017:
